



# KILLING MEDICARE TO PAY FOR TAX BREAKS FOR THE RICH?

That's the Republican plan. Their budget proposal will end Medicare and Medicaid as we know them and dramatically cut programs for children, the poor and the disabled. It slashes funding for programs that aid working families and create jobs and calls for the repeal of the Affordable Care Act.

All of these spending cuts go not to reducing the federal deficit, but to paying for more tax cuts for corporations and the very wealthiest Americans. The Republican budget lowers the top marginal income tax rate from 35% to 25%. It also makes the Bush tax cuts permanent and lowers the estate tax for the rich. And it reduces the corporate tax rate from 35% to 25% and continues subsidies to the oil and gas industry while doing nothing to close loopholes that allow corporations like GE to pay zero taxes in 2010 on \$14 billion worth of profits.

It's time to stop robbing the middle class, seniors, children and the working poor in order to give even more to the wealthy and corporations.
